

European Research Council (ERC) Synergy Grants (SyG)

Aim	 Funding a group of 2 to 4 researchers (and their teams) working together with complementary skills on an interdisciplinary and ground-breaking research project to tackle problems that cannot be solved by a single researcher alone Funding of frontier research in any field of research
Target group	 Researchers of any nationality and age Researchers with competitive track records as appropriate to their research career
Time commitment	Minimum 30% on the ERC project and minimum 50% in Europe
Host institutions	Located in EU-Member States or Associated Countries to Horizon Europe; one host allowed to be placed in a Third Country
Funding	 Funding for up to 6 years Max. 10 million EUR (possibly + 4 million EUR for major equipment, researchers moving from Third Countries to Europe or major experimental or field work costs)
Budget	300 million EUR (estimated number of grants: 30)
Application	 Annual call for proposals One-stage proposal submission Electronically via the Funding and Tenders Portal
Evaluation	 Three-stage evaluation process (peer review) Interview at the third step of evaluation
Next call for proposals	 Opening: 13 July 2022 Submission deadline: 8 November 2022
Success rates	• 2021: no call, 2020: 7.7%, 2019: 13%, 2018: 8.8%
