Which funding opportunity fits your research career?

Both the **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowship (MSCA PF)** and the **European Research Council Starting Grant (ERC StG)** support excellent researchers under Horizon Europe.

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship

Best for researchers who want to:

- ✓ Gain international research experience
- ✓ Develop new scientific and transferable skills
- ✓ Benefit from structured supervision and mentoring
- ✓ Strengthen their CV for future independent funding
- ✓ Starting to build their research independence

Key Features

- Strong emphasis on training and career development
- Mandatory international mobility
- Individual fellowship focused on the fellow's development
- Excellent stepping stone towards future leadership grants

ERC Starting Grant

Best for researchers who:

- ✓ Have an established scientific track record
- ✓ Demonstrate research independence
- ✓ Have a bold, innovative research vision
- ✓ Want to build and lead a research team
- ✓ Aim to become a recognised research leader

Key Features

- Focus on groundbreaking frontier research
- Full scientific independence
- Large-scale, flexible funding
- Opportunity to establish long-term research leadership

What do they have in common?

Both schemes:

- Fund excellent researchers through Horizon Europe.
- Are open to researchers of any nationality.
- Require a host institution in an EU Member State or Associated Country.
- Use international peer review.
- Promote excellence and strengthen the European Research Area.

Choose MSCA PF if:

- You need additional training and skills development.
- You want to expand your network through mobility.
- You are still building your research independence.
- Your project supports your career development goals.

Choose ERC StG if:

- You already demonstrated independence.
- You have a strong publication and achievement record.
- You are ready to lead a team and manage significant funding.
- Your research aims to push the boundaries of knowledge.

A career pathway, not a competition

Many researchers use an **MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship** to develop expertise, gain international experience, and build a competitive profile before successfully applying for an **ERC Starting Grant** later in their career.

MSCA PF → Research Independence → ERC Starting Grant

MSCA PF develops researchers. ERC StG develops research leaders.

The best choice depends on the career stage, track record, and long-term research ambitions.
